Contact Your Physician if You Experience the Following Symptoms

- Temperature over 101 degrees F or severe chills
- Persistent nausea or vomiting
- Severe pain not relieved by medication
- Excessive or persistent bleeding
- Excessive swelling
- Follow the labeled instructions on your prescription(s)
- If you have received general anesthesia:
- DO NOT drive or drink alcohol for at least 24 hours after discharge from the hospital
- <u>DO NOT</u> make any important decisions or sign any important papers for 24 hours after discharge from the hospital
- If you are taking pain medication do not drive or drink alcohol
- Have a responsible adult remain with you for the remainder of the day and during the night

Specific instructions:

- Sponge bathe only, you may use Bandage or Cast Bag
- Apply ice packs to surgical area 20 minutes on, 5 minutes off for the first 24 hours
- Elevate feet above the level of the heart for the first two (2) days as often as possible
- Keep bandages <u>clean</u> and <u>dry</u> contact your doctor immediately if your bandage should get wet.
- Follow specific instructions regarding weight-bearing status of the operative foot
